Lift Station a Go for Fort McMurray Eco-Industrial Park

Last Piece of Sewer System Falls Into Place

Fort McMurray, Alberta, Canada – April 28, 2009

TaigaNova Eco-Industrial Park will get a custom designed sanitary lift station this year, meaning all sewer services will be in operation this fall. Wood Buffalo Housing and Development Corporation (WBHDC) has awarded the \$3M lift station construction project to Alpha Construction Inc.

The lift station, which was designed specifically for the site by Associated Engineering (AE), has a unique circular design. This means it will use less aggregate, concrete, and rebar compared to a traditional lift station. Further efficiencies have been realized by designing a single station to serve three different developments along Hwy 63. Operating and maintaining only one lift station rather than three will mean significant savings over the life of the structure.

Alpha Construction will begin work on the lift station in May. Alpha is a full service general contracting company specializing in light industrial, municipal and commercial construction in Alberta since 1999.

AE has provided consulting engineering services for over 60 years and was recently awarded the distinction of being one of the 50 best managed companies in Canada.

Construction of the lift station is scheduled to be completed in September.
